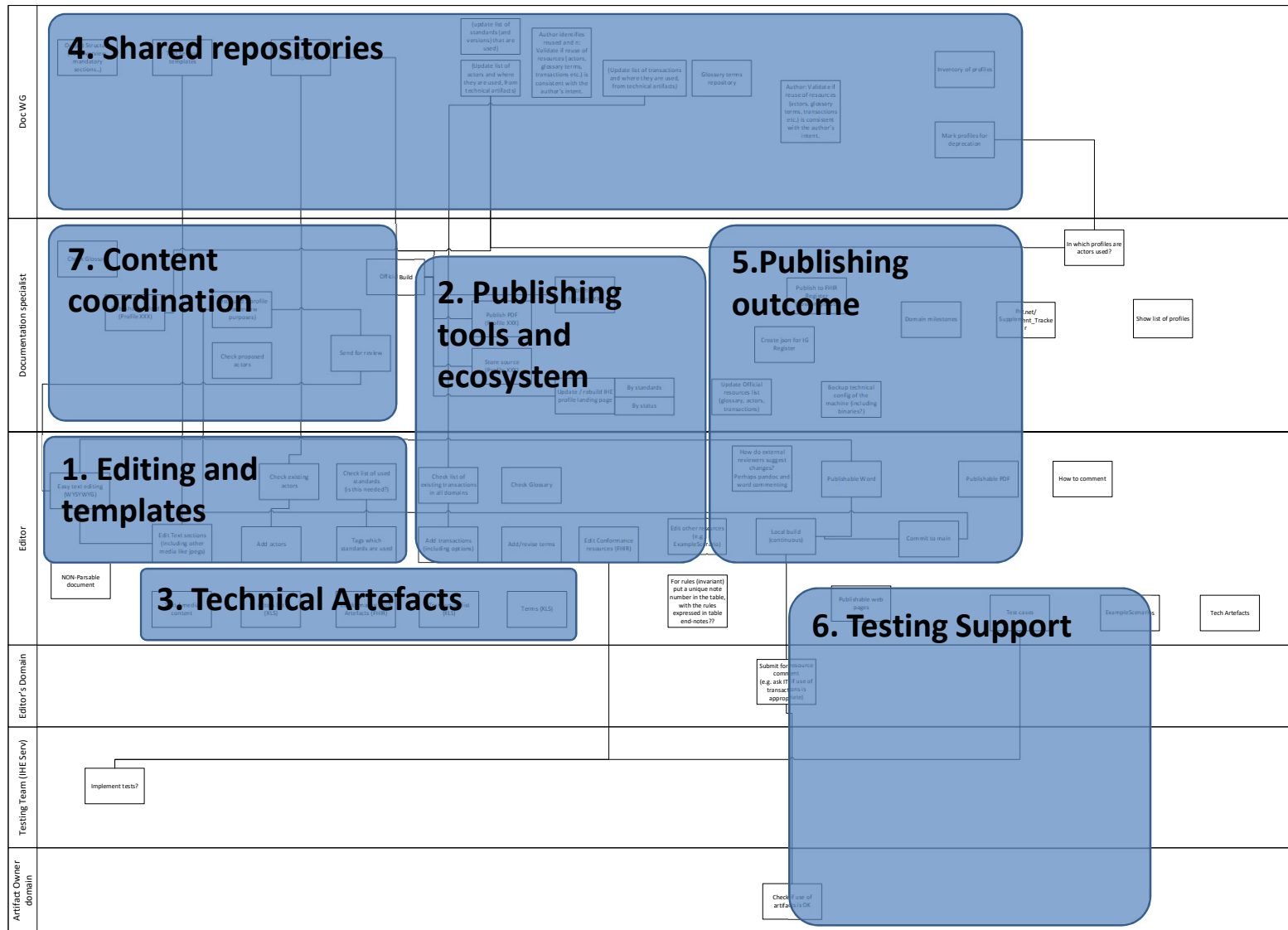

1. Editing tools and templates

- **How does a user edit IHE content: text and structured resources**
- Reusing content as much as possible (glossary entries, actors , templates, figures...)
 - From IHE repositories (to define)
 - From external repositories (SKMT, Reference data, etc.)
- Overlapping with tool selection

2. Publishing tools and ecosystem

Procure / develop tools for processing and handling the artifacts

- Defining Roles and Responsibilities
- Tooling selection (list requirements, buy vs build, cost/value...)

3. Technical artefacts and Conformance statements

- **Define which (& where) are needed the technical resources**
 - Conformance resources
 - Content
 - Workflow
 - Value sets
 - ExampleScenarios
 - Test scripts
 - ...

4. Repositories

- **Define what and where to store needed content.**
- Structure – per profile/per year?..
- May overlap with tool selection (e.g. github)
- Transition plan from As Is.

5. Publishing outcome and templates

- **What do we want to publish? HTML? Hosted where? PDF? Word?**
- Also:
- Templates, logos, pagination rules...
- Profile stacking and track changes
- Define Profiles pages, landing page, release notes...
- Normativeness declaration of the content (e.g. xmls are normative, narrative is informative. See also stream 8 for conformance)
- Overlapping with tool selection

6. Testing Support

- **How can our target testing ecosystem benefit from this?**
- Link to Gazelle / other test tools
- Enable testing, test results publication, certification...

7. Content coordination

- **How to maintain any of our content across domains, across versions...**
- Hot to include Community feedback to the profiles,...
- How to maintain repositories (Actors, transactions,...) and their lifecycle
- Activating / deprecating content

8. Accreditation / compliance / IP aspects

- **Ensuring process deviations do not cause regression or a lowering of standards**
