1. The Committee approved the Planning Committee September 18 2009 minutes. Flora will place on the wiki.	Flora	12/15/2009
2. The group discussed what went well at the meeting and what didn't: -Overall, about 650 people, higher than last year - Steady flow of people - People weren't just there for the flash drive, but wanted an education - There was a lot of word of mouth, people told their friends about it - Physicians are confused, are hungry to know what is available for the marketplace - Well-organized, good venue, good overall - Long workflow may make it difficult to digest – maybe concentrate on interaction between just 2 systems - Use a diagram to show how things fit together/big posters -Consolidating visitors into groups seemed to work well -Have scheduled demonstrations/talks beforehand - Have both options – scheduled groups and presentations at theater, and individuals going through	Planning Committee	
3. The group concluded that the marketing and Showcase have largely been successful but that future efforts should target having more vendors participate in IHE.	Planning Committee	

4. The group discussed possibilities of including more vendors. The group discussed the importance of charge posting, or evidence-based billing. The MPPS completes the information loop so that charges can be based on evidence that procedures have been performed and if changes needed to made, they can be made within the workflow process. Most agreed that much of the value accrues from implementation of modality worklist, i.e., attaching the image with the right patient demographics and including the patient demographics with the image. This allows the correct association of the patient with their image and improves workflow. Another option is to allow for more time for implementation of the IOD once its released, say 1-2 years after release. One option is to lower the bar for participation at the Showcase, without the stigma of the label, “works in progress.” This could be conveyed by handouts showing what exactly had been implemented or not. More needs to be understood about what possible changes mean. A lot of this revolves around business considerations and decisions. The real goal of IHE Eye Care is to drive more standards adoption in the marketplace. This will be discussed in greater detail at the TC meeting next week.	Technical Committee
