- Advanced Patient Privacy Consents (APPC)



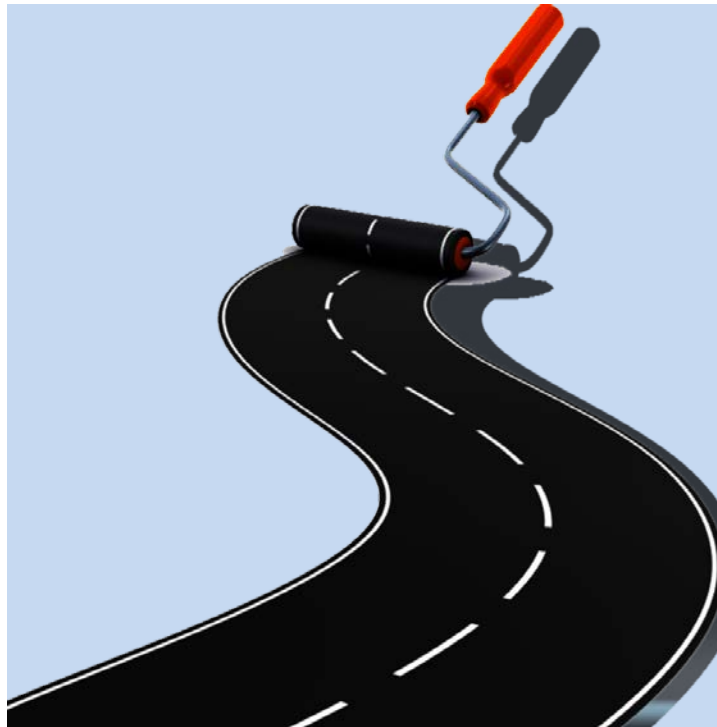
AHIMA Standards Task Force
